## **ENGLISCH Grundstufe (A2) – Mittelstufe Consolidation (B1)**

Wenn Sie kein Englisch in der Schule hatten, aber über in der Erwachsenenbildung erworbene Grundkenntnisse verfügen und diese erweitern möchten, machen Sie diesen Test. Er dient dazu, Sie bei der Wahl des passenden Kurses zu unterstützen.
